

Prayer

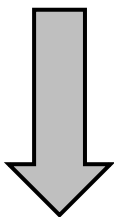
Dear Lord Jesus,

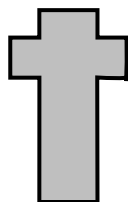

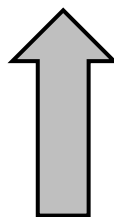

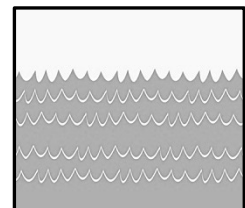

Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice
and spoke out to them, ...

“Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved by God to you by
mighty works and wonders and signs which God did by
him among you,

even as you yourselves know... you have taken Him by
the hand of lawless men, crucified and killed;

whom God raised up, having freed him from the agony of death, because it was not possible that he should be held by it.

“Let all the house of Israel therefore know certainly that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified.”

Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?”

Peter said to them, “Repent, and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
