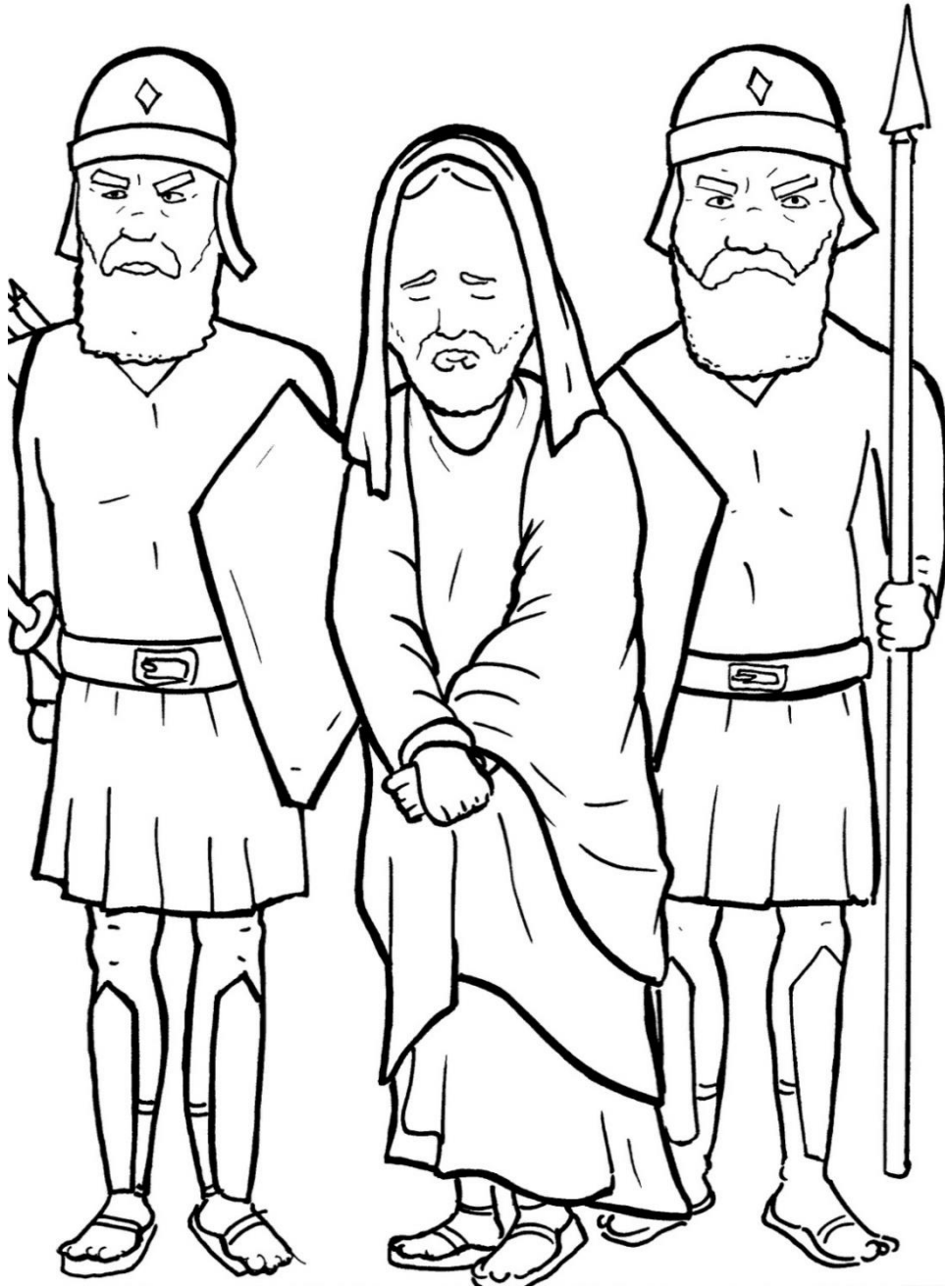




Pilate asked the crowd, "What should I do with Jesus?"

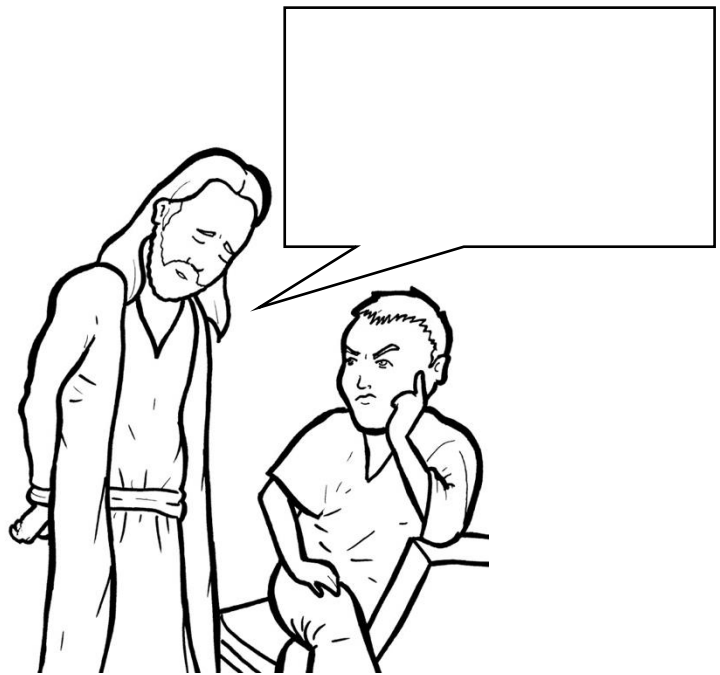
"Crucify him," they shouted. And so, Jesus decided to die on the cross. He knew his death would save us.

37. Jesus is Arrested

Luke 22: 47-54, 70; John 19:1-3; 5-7,15-16 World English Bible (WEB)

Judas, one of the twelve, came near to Jesus to kiss him.

But Jesus said to him, "Judas, do you betray the Son of Man with a kiss?"

When those who were around him saw what was about to happen, they said to him, "Lord, shall we strike with the sword?" A certain one of them struck the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear.

But Jesus answered, "Let me at least do this" - and he touched his ear, and healed him. Jesus said to the chief priests, captains of the temple, and elders, who had come against him, "Have you come out as against a robber, with swords and clubs? When I was with you in the temple daily, you didn't stretch out your hands against me. But this is your hour, and the power of darkness." They seized him, and led him away, and brought him into the high priest's house.

They all said, "Are you then the Son of God?"

He said to them, "You say it, because I am."

So, Pilate then took Jesus, and flogged him. The soldiers twisted thorns into a crown, and put it on his head, and dressed him in a purple garment. They kept saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" and they kept slapping him. Jesus therefore came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple garment. Pilate said to them, "Behold, the man!"
