

4. Jesus wants you to spend time with him. Are you willing to do this each day? When?

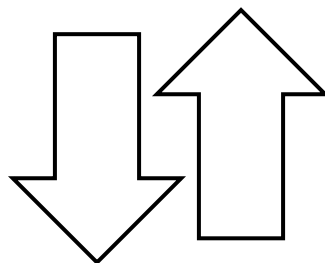
Prayer

Mark 14:32 – 44, 50 World English Bible (WEB)

They came to a place which was named Gethsemane.

He said to his disciples, "Sit here, while I pray."

He took with him Peter, James, and John,

and began to be greatly troubled and distressed.

He said to them, "My soul is exceedingly sorrowful,

even to death. Stay here, and watch."

He went forward a little, and fell on the ground,

away from him. He said, "Abba, Father, all things are

However, not what I desire, but what you desire."

He came and found them sleeping, and said to Peter,
